TESTS: All tests offered. Event tests (new 2010!) and USDF Intro in 20 x 40m ring all others in 20 x 60m ring. Duplicate tests allowed, but second ride will be HC.

FEES: Intro/Event - \$25; Dressage tests - \$30; SHV 2-Phase - \$50; In-Hand - \$25

DRESS: Riders dress warm and casual. Horses may use bandages and boots, however tack rules apply. (Unconventional tack may ride HC.) **Bitless bridles** allowed in Sport Horse Versatility Two-Phase.

AWARDS: Trophy towels through fourth. Series championships may be awarded if entries warrant. NCDCTA points in dressage classes.

NON-COMPETING HORSES: Submit entry, coggins and \$20.

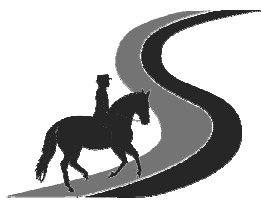

SHV CLASSES OFFERED

SHV Two-Phase - A two-phase class designed to show the refinement and teamwork between horse and rider. The Refined Riding Phase is a dressage test, see below for available tests offered. The Working Phase is an obstacle course of 6-9 elements. **\$50 includes dressage test and obstacle course.**

Dressage tests offered for this class: Intro B, Training 3 or Second 1.

On entry form, indicate which dressage test you will be riding. Dressage test score will also count towards the Dressage only portion of the show. SHV class(es) will be split as entries warrant.

Bitless bridles are allowed in Sport Horse Versatility

In-Hand Class - Exhibitors will show their horses in-hand over 6-9 obstacles at a walk and trot. Exhibitors may be asked to lead their horse from the left or right side. Exhibitors may use a leather, nylon or rope halter. No stud chains. **\$25** This is an in-hand class only. It does not include a dressage test.

The versatility course will be open for schooling after the conclusion of all judged rounds.
